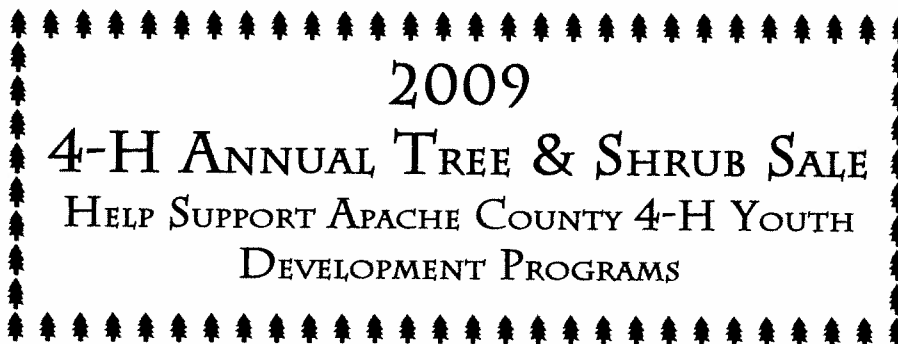

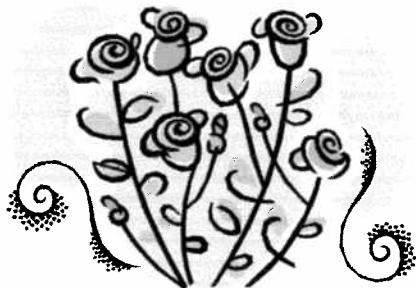

2009 4-H TREE & SHRUB DESCRIPTION



SHRUBS

1. **COMMON PURPLE LILAC**- Fragrant lilac colored blossoms in May. Attractive green foliage.
2. **LATE LILAC**- Dense shrub. Very hardy. Blooms later than other lilacs. Flowers very light rosy lilac to white.
3. **TATARIAN HONEYSUCKLE**- Neat appearing shrub for screens and windbreaks. Dependable and hardy. Pale pink buds open to profusion of white blooms.
4. **RUGOSA ROSE**- Red flowered, 2-3" bloom.
5. **RUGOSA ROSE**- White flowered, 2-3" bloom.
6. **COMMON PRIVET**- Shrub to 15' if unsheared. Commonly used as either a sheared or unsheared hedge. Foliage is distinct dark green, white flowers.
7. **WEeping FORSYTHIA**- Upright arching habit provides "golden fountain" effect during early spring bloom. Yellow fall color. Adaptable to most soil types. Will tolerate some shade/drought, best bloom in full sun.
8. **ROSE OF SHARON**- Dense upright flowering shrub, saucer-shaped summer blooms red-purple to blue-lavender, occasionally white. Good screen or specimen plant.

FRUIT TREES

9. **PEACH, RED HAVEN**- Medium, nearly fuzzless red fruit with yellow freestone flesh. Excellent fresh, canning and freezing quality. Abundant cropping requires thinning. Ripens late June to early August. Self-fertile.
10. **BRAEBURN APPLE**- Medium to large firm fruit, orange-red blush over yellow-green, tangy, crisp, very juicy, sweet flavor. Excellent fresh eating/cooking. Good keeper. Ripens October to November.
11. **APRICOT, MOORPARK**- Very large, sweet, juicy deep orange flesh. Smoother golden-yellow skin with orange-red blush. Excellent for fresh eating, canning or drying. Long ripening period, early July to late August. Self-fertile.
12. **MONTMORENCY CHERRY**- Pie cherry favorite, medium to large tart fruit. Requires well-drained/aerated soils. Self-fertile.
13. **STELLA CHERRY**- Good producer of large, dark red fruit. Ripens mid-June. Self-fertile and is a good pollinator for other sweet cherries.

14. **CAMPFIRE AMUR MAPLE** (like the one on the east side of Bank The of West in SJ)
15. **BURGAMBEL OAK**- Vigorous, fast growing, hybrid oak. Compact, shrubby crown. Excellent wildlife habitat, heavy early acorn production.
