

APACHE COUNTY 4-H RECORD BOOK INFORMATION SHEET

PURPOSE OF A 4-H RECORD BOOK

The four main purposes or objectives of a 4-H Record Book are:

1. To enable 4-H youth, with help from their leader, to set project goals at the beginning of the year and work together to accomplish them.
2. To teach youth about financial accountability of a project.
3. To reflect learning situations that youth were involved in.
4. To have a history of 4-H activities that youth participated in.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR 4-H RECORD BOOK

Your 4-H Record Book should be in the following sequence:

Table of contents
4-H Story –**Please use the new 4-H story format**—on the green sheet
My Cumulative 4-H Resume
Project Plan and Financial Accountability Form for each project
Pictures (limited to 2 pages per year)

Your 4-H Record Book should be arranged by year. The current year should be on top of the previous year.

Use additional paper as needed to complete the various forms.

Reminder: Prior to submitting your 4-H Record Book to the 4-H Office, the 4-H member, parent and 4-H leader must sign on page 4 of the Apache County 4-H Project Plan and Financial Accountability Form.
