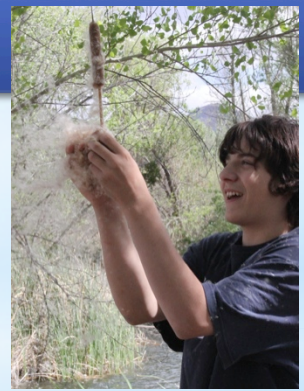


Water Investigations Program 2011-2012 Teacher Cohort

For teachers of 6th, 7th, and 8th grades
and their students in the Phoenix Valley

In one year, your students will:

- Improve critical thinking skills
- Investigate water use at your school
- Conduct real scientific investigations outdoors
- Communicate scientific conclusions to adult decision-makers

January 11 and March 10, 2012

Over the 2011-2012 school year, the Water Investigations Program will focus on critical thinking skills using the relevant subject of water. Students will build *connections between urban water use and Arizona's riparian areas*, culminating in a field trip to a riparian area to conduct their own research investigations. Take this opportunity to embed STEM subjects in to your curriculum.

Teachers will attend six days of professional development that will cover three thematic units: *Water Use Inquiry, Water Resources & Supply Inquiry and Riparian Inquiry*.

Benefits include a \$500 stipend, in-classroom mentoring, support from APW throughout the year, and a free, all-day field trip for your students.
