 - ___ Nutrition/Food Preparation

- ✓ Two hundred forty clock hours of verified occupational employment in Family and Consumer Sciences or an internship of 2 units or more.
- ✓ Eighteen additional hours of professional knowledge, including any of the following:
 - ___ Principles/philosophy of vocational education
 - ___ Operation of a vocational student organization
 - ___ Methods of teaching occupational family and consumer science
 - ___ Curriculum design/development (includes assessment and evaluation)
 - ___ Instructional technology

- ✓ Passing score on the secondary professional knowledge portion of Arizona Educator Proficiency Assessment (AEPA).
