

RECORD BOOK GUIDELINES

Attending a showmanship workshop is **not** exhibiting. It should be listed under **Showmanship**.

Challenge Day, both county and state, to be listed under **Other 4-H Activities** as Triathlon. **Do not** separate the three parts of the event into Demonstration, Judging, Test. It is **one** event, a Triathlon. The ribbon won is for the whole event.

Grab Bag demo's done at Challenge Day **are not** to be listed under Demonstrations and counted as your demonstration required to be a member in good standing.

Reports given at a club meeting on events attended or upcoming **are not** to be listed under Demonstrations.

Definition -

Club level event - a club activity available to all members in that club or particular project within the club.

County level event - an activity put on by the County 4-H Office and Project Directors. Open to all members regardless of which club. Event may be sponsored by a club if it is open to **all** 4-H members in that project.

State level event - sponsored by the State 4-H Office or a county, but available to members throughout the state. Examples - State Dog Show, State Horse Show, Colorado River Small Stock Show, Jolt, State Challenge Day.

Always list years in 2 year span - 91-92, 92-93, etc.

4-H Events Only

Talk and Demonstrations - list here only talks and demonstrations for which you have spent time preparing. No reports, no Grab Bag demo from Challenge Day. A talk teaches a concept or idea. A demonstration shows how to do something.

Exhibits - list animals, posters, projects that have been judged or displayed for others to view.

Judging and Showmanship - Judging is when **you are the judge**. Showmanship is when **you are being judged in the handling of your animal**.

Other 4-H Activities

These are **planned** activities of your club or county or state. Examples - 4-H Camp, Recognition Night, club fundraisers, club recreational activities, Jolt, Challenge Day, Clean-up Day.

Things that you do on your own, such as visiting a swine breeder, should be listed in your Project Plan as a learning situation or things you did.

If you do a talk or demo at school or for non-4-H group, list it under Special Appearance. List only **non-4-H group**.
