



**Attention All Transfer of Property Inspectors of Onsite  
Wastewater Treatment Systems**

**Did you know that you are now required to attend an ADEQ-approved course *before* initiating the real estate inspection? If you have not attended a course, you should consider attending the University of Arizona sponsored *NAWT Inspection Training & Certification* course approved by ADEQ.**

Your successful completion of the 2-day course and certification test will result in your name being listed as a certified inspector with both NAWT and ADEQ. This list is posted on the NAWT website ([www.nawt.org](http://www.nawt.org)) and is visited by property owners and Realtors engaged in the **Arizona Transfer Inspection Program under AAC R18-9-A316. *This course is a pre-requisite for both the Arizona Soil & Site Evaluation for Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems and Introduction to Design of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Workshops.***
