



Attention All Transfer of Property Inspectors of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems

Did you know that each eligible inspector is required to attend an ADEQ-approved course before initiating the real estate inspection? If you have not attended a course, you should consider attending the University of Arizona sponsored NAWT Inspection Training & Certification course approved by ADEQ.

After successful completion of the 2-day National Association of Wastewater Transporters, Inc. (NAWT) Inspection Training & Certification course and certification test, you are recognized as a nationally-certified inspector by NAWT, you are listed on a national registry (www.nawt.org) of certified industry professionals for two years, you meet one (1) of three (3) Arizona administrative rule requirements permitting you to conduct inspections for the Arizona Transfer of Ownership program. This course is a pre-requisite for both the Arizona Soil & Site Evaluation for Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems and Introduction to Design of Onsite Wastewater Treatment courses.

Cost: \$300 for early registration (until Jan 12) and \$350 for late registration (Jan 13-Jan 21). Registration includes workshop, manuals, certification exam, and breaks. Lunch is on your own. If re-certifying, please indicate on registration form (attendance is only required on the second day for recertification); the cost is \$200 for early registration (until Jan 12) and \$250 for late registration (Jan 13-Jan 21). Reduced fees available for state, county, and city employees, please inquire. Multiple employees from same company qualify for 10% discount.

Policies: Preregistration and prepayment is required. No onsite registrations accepted. Registration will be confirmed upon receipt of fees. Cancellations within one week of workshop will result in half refund of payment.

Other Certification: This workshop qualifies for 16 Professional Development Hours (PDHs) for Arizona Wastewater Treatment Operators and 13.5 contact hours for AZ Registered Sanitarians when attending both days (half the hours when attending one day).
