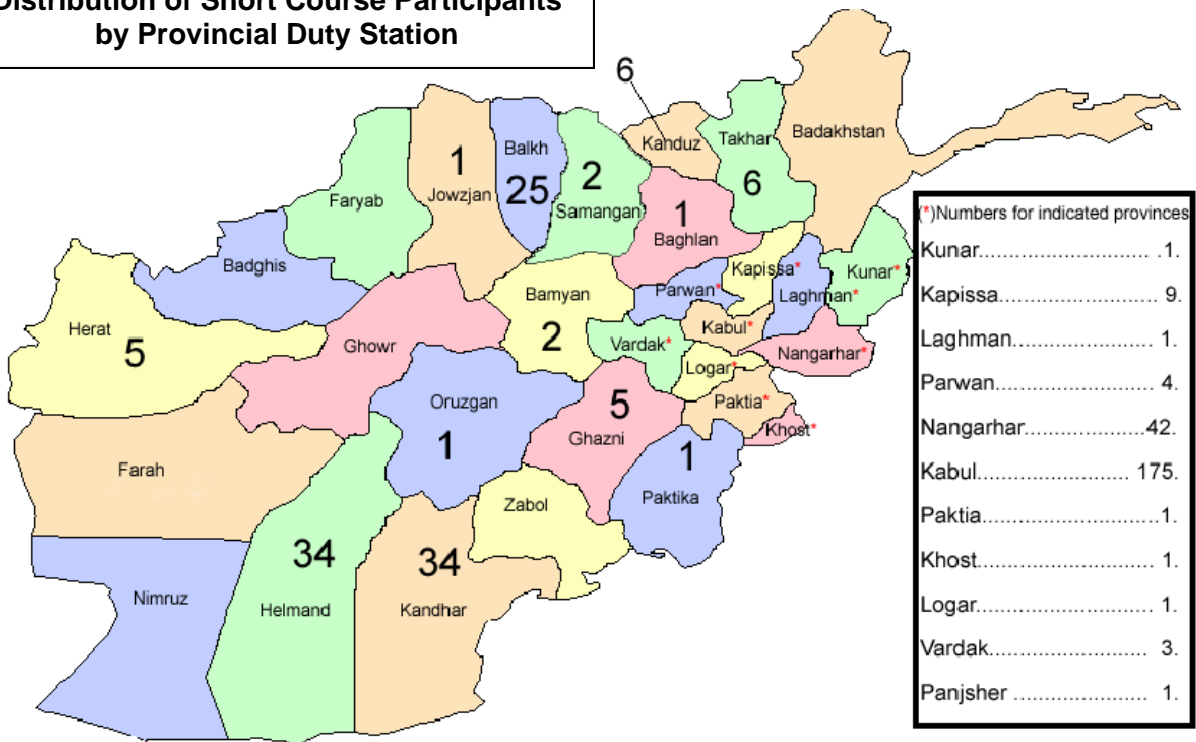


# Human Capacity Development for the Agriculture Sector in Afghanistan

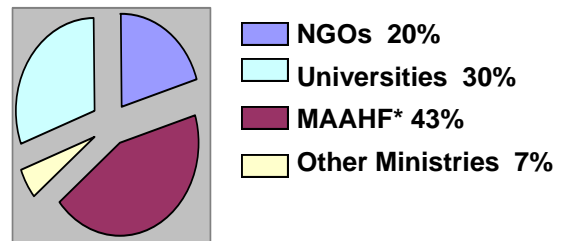
**Distribution of Short Course Participants by Provincial Duty Station**

A total of 361 Afghan agriculturalists have completed one-month “train the trainers” courses on 15 assorted topics such as: Irrigation Management, Orchard Management, Post Harvest Handling/Marketing, Enterprise Development, Animal Nutrition, and Integrated Pest Management. Thirty-six women were among the total who have completed the 19 courses offered thus far. These training programs are being delivered by our partner institution, the NWFP Agricultural University in Peshwar, Pakistan. This short term technical training is having an early impact on the recovering agriculture sector in Afghanistan. For sustainability reasons, we are now including an emphasis on long term M.Sc. degree training.
