Information

Periodically we send out important information — container recycling events, hot regulatory items, etc. We want to encourage everyone to provide us with a current e-mail address. You can update this when you renew your credential.

- **Pest Control Advisors** are required to obtain **15 CEUs** per year of renewal.
- **Commercial Applicators** are required to obtain **6 CEUs** per year of renewal.
- **Private Applicators Ag** are required to obtain **3 CEUs** per year of renewal.
- **Fumigation Certification** - Any Private Applicator Ag or Commercial Applicator acting as a Private Applicator with the fumigation category must obtain an additional 3 CEUs per year of renewal. (*fumigation specific not required*)
- **Private Applicator Golf RUP or Non-RUP** must obtain 3 CEUs per year of renewal.
- **Certifications, licenses and permits** are renewable for a 1 or 2 year period, provided enough CEUs have been obtained.
- **PUPs Ag or Golf, PUCs and PCAs** are able to count CEUs obtained between January 1 through December 31. Certifications, licenses and permits expire on December 31 and must be renewed within 30 days.
- If you do not obtain the CEUs required to renew your certification or license by December 31 — you must retest at one of our office locations in Phoenix, Tucson or Yuma.
