Information

Periodically we send out important information — container recycling events, hot regulatory items, etc. We want to encourage everyone to provide us with a current e-mail address. You can update this when you renew your credential.

- <u>Pest Control Advisors</u> are required to obtain
 15 CEUs per year of renewal.
- <u>Commercial Applicators (PUC)</u> are required to obtain **6 CEUs** per year of renewal.
- <u>Private Applicators (PUP)</u> are required to obtain 3 CEUs per year of renewal.
- Golf Course Applicators (PUG) are required to obtain 3 CEUs per year of renewal.
- Fumigation Certification Any Private Applicator, Golf Course Applicator or Commercial Applicator acting as a Private Applicator with the fumigation category must obtain an additional 3 CEUs per year of renewal. (fumigation specific not required)
- Aquatic Certification- Any Golf Course Applicator with the aquatic category must obtain an additional 3 CEUs per year of renewal.
 (aquatic specific not required)
- <u>Certifications, licenses and permits</u> are renewable for a 1 or 2 year period, provided enough CEUs have been obtained.
- PUPs, PUGs, PUCs and PCAs are able to count CEUs obtained between January 1 through December 31. Certifications, licenses and permits expire on December 31 and must be renewed within 30 days.
- If you do not obtain the CEUs required to renew your certification or license by December 31 — you must retest at one of our office locations in Phoenix, Tucson or Yuma.
